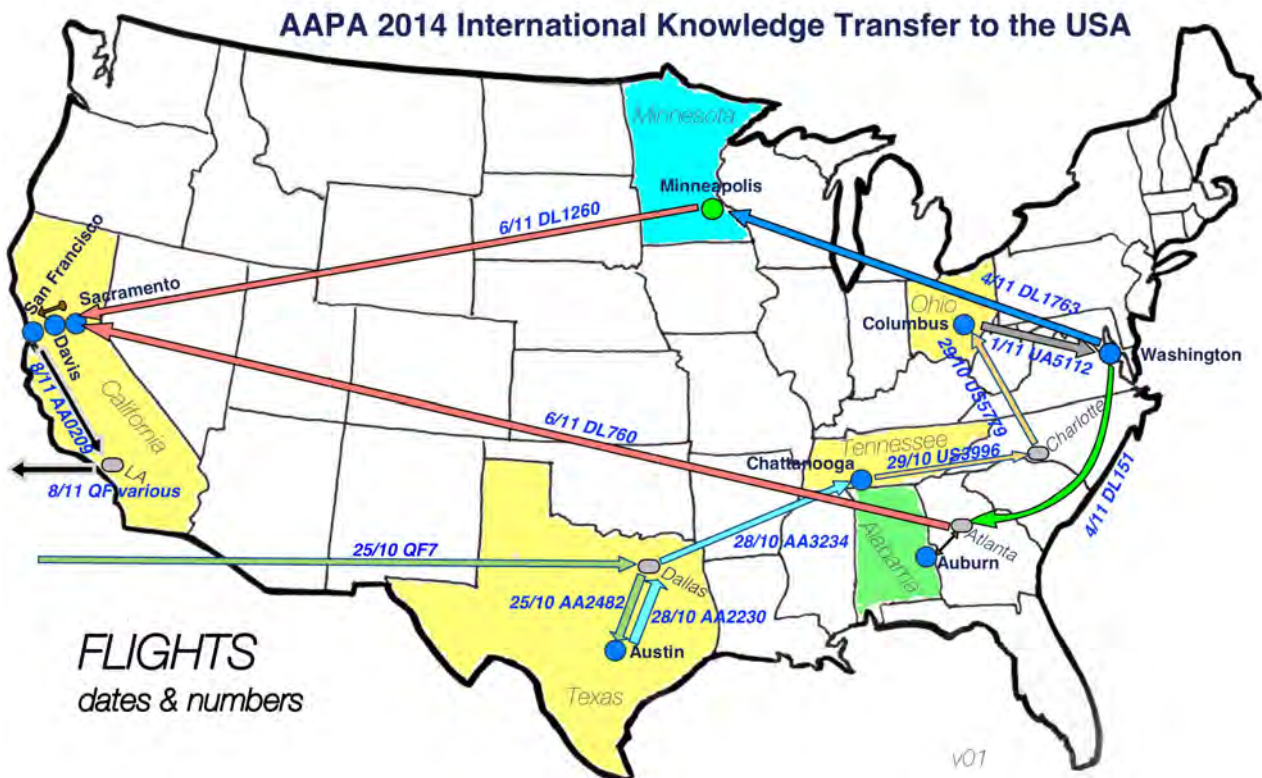

#### **1. Construction:**

Will include the equipment and facilities to achieve improved delivery and the safety standards used. At construction projects members will see in action the latest techniques in asphalt placement and compaction including the process to remove rigid pavements and replace with full depth asphalt.

#### **2. Pavement Engineering:**

Advances in pavement design through innovative and sustainable solutions: including attendance at the International Conference on Perpetual Pavements in Ohio where the Australian Perpetual Pavements developmental works will be shared. Reviews of USA pavement design MEPDG systems will be undertaken at FHWA, NCAT and Caltrans. Innovation and sustainable solutions will cover product and system development through the use of Accelerated Pavement Testing devices and promoting the adoption of innovative and cost reducing pavement materials and surfacing technologies
